

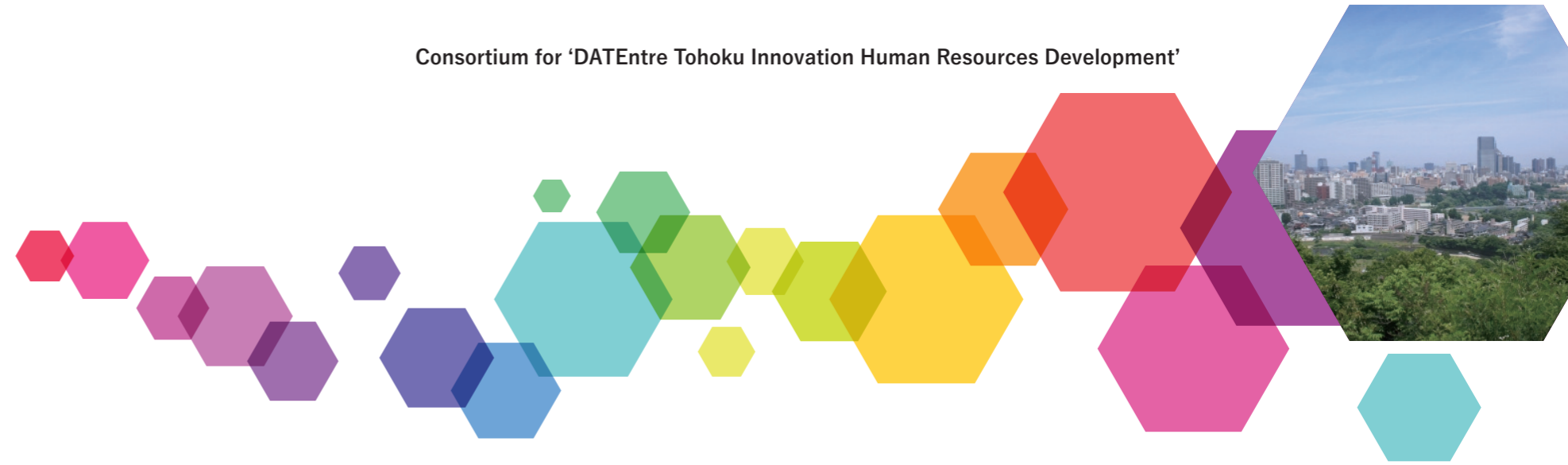

1 Object

This program is designed to help international students who are interested in career development in Japan improve their Japanese language skill and understand Japanese culture, and as well as increase their understanding of customs within Japanese companies and also introduce superior international students from Tohoku Gakuin University, Tohoku Institute of Technology, Miyagi Womens' College and Tohoku University to Japanese businesses and promote employment in the Tohoku region and nationwide.

2 Program outline and number of applicants to be accepted

(1) Program overview

We are recruiting international students to study one of the career development courses as below.

① Regional Creation Course

Aim for human resources who will contribute to the development of the local economy immediately after graduation by working at local companies.

Collaboration on projects of management know-how at OJT (On the Job Training) through internships, deepens an understanding of Japanese style human resources / production management, procurement of materials and quality control, as well as to plan to develop human resources with SMEs facing the absence of successors, and with companies that are considering or have plans to expand overseas or collaboration to lead companies in the future.

② Entrepreneur Development Course

Actively interact with young entrepreneurs, business owners or investors of venture companies and acquire knowledge, qualities and the skills necessary to succeed as entrepreneurs.

Learn the process of establishing a company by developing business plans based on plans that take advantage of specialties and experience. In addition, through experiences of participation in domestic and international business contests and the development of new businesses while still a student, acquire the ability to connect outstanding creative insight and inventiveness to new businesses.

③ Global Business Course

We aim to find employment in major Japanese companies leading the international community, or international companies in Japan. Specialized for international students so they can acquire the knowledge and skills to understand the culture, customs and work style of large Japanese companies, how to execute industry / company research, how to write an entry sheet, and examination measures, interviewing procedures, etc. necessary for job hunting. Learning to act as leader of the organization, after assignment (joining the company), as a mentor to support job hunting activities for program participants.

As a learning activity common to all courses, we aim for students to reach the level of N1 in the Japanese Language Proficiency Test through a high-quality Japanese language education program suited to the needs of each student and for students to thoroughly learn business Japanese. The program will involve work on problem solving (PBL) type collaborative projects with Japanese students and intern at SME businesses.

(2) Number of students to be accepted (all courses) : 50 students

3 Application qualification

- (1) Students must be enrolled as a regular student at a university participating in Tohoku Innovation Human Resources Development Consortium (Tohoku Gakuin University, Tohoku Institute of Technology, Tohoku University, Miyagi Gakuin Women's University) (including expected enrollment from October 1st 2018) as an undergraduate or postgraduate international student
- (2) Students who have achieved a score of 65 points or more in the online test "SPOT90 (Simple Performance - Oriented Test Ver. 90). (All applicants must complete the SPOT 90 + Grammar 90 + Kanji SPOT 50 set online personal examination in advance, print out and submit the result with the application form to <http://ttbj1.cegloc.tsukuba.ac.jp/apply/agree/>)

(3) Students who can be proactively involved in the lessons and extracurricular activities provided by this program (The estimated time for the program is 4 to 6 hours a week.

(4) Students who intend to obtain work in Japanese businesses after graduation.

(5) Students who intend to participate in mid- to long-term internships and course programs to be implemented in this program.

5 Application procedure

When submitting please write "Tohoku Innovation Human Resources Development Program Application" as the subject.

6 Selection method

Students for the program are selected by a comprehensive analysis of the application documents.

7 Publication of Result

Applicants will be notified of the results by email on Friday, the 29th September.

8 Program Period

11 Certificate of completion of program

Certification will be awarded to those who successfully complete the prescribed curriculum.

12 Program fee

Free of charge ※However, payment of fees may be required if transportation and accommodation expenses are incurred.

13 Others

- (1) Private paying international students with excellent grades who take this program, may be eligible for learning incentive scholarships. Candidates may be recommended from the "International Student Employment Promotion Program Special Framework"
- (2) The procedures for changing the status of residence may be eased in the event that a person completing this program is employed by a participating company.
