Change of Venue for March 2022 Tohoku University Commencement Ceremony

Due to the earthquake that occurred on Wednesday, March 16, the venue of the

commencement ceremony scheduled for Friday, March 25 has been changed from the

Kamei Arena Sendai (Sendai City Gymnasium) to the Kawauchi Hagi Hall. There will be

no change in the opening times of the ceremony, which will be held in two sessions, one

for the graduate students and the other for the undergraduate students.

Due to the capacity of the Kawauchi Hagi Hall (1,235 seats), it is anticipated that not all

graduating students who wish to participate in the ceremony will be able to enter the

venue, so the Kawauchi North Campus lecture hall will be prepared as a satellite venue.

All graduating students are currently requested to reply to the attendance confirmation

form, and their cooperation would be highly appreciated.

In the event the capacity of the venue is exceeded in the session starting at 10 am for

graduate students, attending students will be admitted in the venue on a first-come-first-

served basis, and those who cannot enter the Kawauchi Hagi Hall will be able to watch

the ceremony live video at the satellite venue.

For undergraduate students who will attend the noon session, they are cordially asked

for cooperation in using the satellite venue as much as possible if they plan to continue

their studies at the graduate school at Tohoku University if the capacity of the venue is

exceeded.

In addition, attendees are asked to take the measures, such as temperature check on

the morning of the event, wearing a non-woven mask, installing COCOA to smart phones,

etc., in order to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus when they attend the

ceremony.
