

Title: A Notice about Taking Thorough Measures to Help Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 during the New Year Holiday Period

To Dear all Faculty member and students,

As the number of people infected by COVID-19 is increasing nationwide, Miyagi Prefecture has issued a 'Miyagi Medical Emergency Declaration' to further promote efforts to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. At Tohoku University, the number of infections among students and employees has continued to increase since November. An alert entitled 'A Notice about Measures to Help Prevent the Spread of COVID-19' was issued on December 9, 2022.

Please inform those within your department that each individual should recognize the elevated risk of infection due to greater levels of contact with other people during the New Year holiday period. Please encourage them to continue to take action to both prevent themselves from becoming infected and to not infect others.
